

A Billionaire's Hamptons Home

Jonathan Oringer, the billionaire founder and executive chairman of global photography provider Shutterstock, has listed his modern Hamptons home for \$52 million.

Mr. Oringer bought the Bridgehampton, N.Y., property in 2014 for \$40 million, according to public records. The 10,296-square-foot home was designed by architecture firm Barnes Coy Architects, according to a digital brochure of the listing.

The move to list comes roughly six months after Mr. Oringer and his wife Talia Oringer paid \$42 million for a home on Miami Beach's tony North Bay Road. Mr. Oringer recently relocated to Florida and has said he is investing in tech startups in the Miami area.

The home sits on approximately 2 oceanfront acres with just over 160 feet of water frontage. The brochure high-

lights an expansive outdoor living area with 1,800 square feet of patios and terraces that lead to a private lighted walkway down to the beach.

Inside, an elevator offers access to all three floors of the home, with an open living, dining and kitchen area, a media room with a bar, a gym and a game room with a spa that leads to the pool deck. Walnut and limestone floors line the home, while floor-to-ceiling glass windows and doors maximize the light and views of the ocean.

Upper floor bedrooms look out over the property's surrounding dunes and waterfront. The master suite occupies an entire floor and connects to an office, a bathroom with a soaking tub and a private terrace. There are six additional bedroom suites as well as a two-bedroom staff apartment. There are 12 bathrooms total, all finished with custom stonework.

In addition to plentiful patio space, there is a heated infinity edge pool with a sun shelf, an outdoor kitchen and living room with its own grilling station, and a fireplace and a television.

Mr. Oringer didn't respond to a request for comment. The listing is with Erica Grossman and Michaela Kesler of Douglas Elliman, who declined to comment.
